Who is it for?	This course is aimed at high or low risk employers and employees to meet their legal obligation for First Aid Provision in the workplace. If you require a nominated First Aider for the workplace then this is the course for you. The course is delivered specific to the workplace and will give the employee a good understanding of first aid and how to respond in an emergency situation. This is the only course that enables your employee to be called a qualified 'First Aider'

Course Duration:	18 Hours The course consists of 18 hours contact teaching time. Normally the course is run over 3 days with 6 hours contact training per day. Typically the course will run from 9:30am-4:30pm to include a half hour lunch and two 15 minute coffee breaks in the morning and afternoon
